Responsibilities and Duties

The Thunder Bay High School Student Support Worker's responsibilities and duties include and are not limited to:

- Be available for students at any time, including during and after school hours;
- Provide emotional and academic support, including assistance with homework and school projects;
- Make on-the-spot decisions in emergency situations and provide crisis intervention as needed;
- Notify supervisors or management immediately of any urgent safety or health situations;
- Transport students to various school-related activities and appointments as needed;
- Maintain open communication with students, parents, school staff, and other service providers;
- Ensure that the environment is culturally safe, incorporating First Nations cultural traditions and practices in daily interactions;
- Operate with a mobile office, meeting students at various locations as needed;
- Be prepared to assist in emergency situations, including being available outside regular working hours.

- Grade 12 diploma or equivalent (post-secondary education in a related field is an asset);
- Experience working with Indigenous youth and communities is an asset;
- Experience working with communities in the North and understanding the impact of generational trauma is required;
- Proficiency in Anishnabemowin is an asset;
